## Endorsement of Cambodia's Strategic Program for Climate Resilience (SPCR) under the PPCR

It is my pleasure to confirm that the PPCR Sub-Committee reviewed the *Strategic Program for Climate Resilience*: *Cambodia*, and endorsed the SPCR as a basis for the further development of the projects foreseen in the strategic program and took note of the requested funding of USD 50 million in grant funding and USD 55 million in other concessional resources.

The Sub-Committee reconfirmed its decision on the allocation of resources, adopted at its meetings in June 2010 and 2011, that the range of funding agreed for a single country pilot program is USD 40-50 million in grant resources, and USD 36 million in other concessional resources recognizing that the minimum amount of the range is more likely and that the upper limit of the range will depend on availability of funding.

The Sub-Committee also called for contributors and other countries, MDBs and other development partners to seek to mobilize additional resources to allow the full funding of the SPCR.

We would like to warmly congratulate Mr. Meas Sophal, Ministry of Environment, and Mr. Tauch Chan Kresna, Ministry of Economy and Finance on the excellent presentation they made to the Sub-Committee to introduce the strategic program.

In endorsing the SPCR, the Sub-Committee requested the Government of Cambodia and the Asian Development Bank to make every effort to strengthen coordination and consultation across ministries and to leverage additional resources for mainstreaming, coordination and capacity development. The Sub-Committee invited the Asian Development Bank, in consultation with other development partners, to assist Cambodia in preparing the projects and programs identified in its SPCR.

We look forward to receiving proposals for the projects and programs identified in Cambodia's SPCR for approval of PPCR funding by the Sub-Committee.
