**Comments from B.E.A. International on the Approval by mail of PPCR Funding:  
Grenada: Proposal for Phase 1 Funding**

Thank you for sharing the Grenada PPCR proposal. It is well written and communicates very strong and essential elements of intervention for climate change resilience. A few points for consideration are as follows:

Page 16 Figure 1 on Institutional Arrangements should have some linkages to private sector coordination, participation and or contribution into the PPCR process.

The role of private sector is limited in the proposal although considering the fact that Grenada is vulnerable to effects of climate change, and some of the resources and economic opportunities thrive from tourism, agriculture and fisheries, private sector has a major role in the PPCR process and should be given some consideration.

It is also necessary to look into other instruments of Public Private Partnerships (PPP) and identify what sort of gaps can be addressed within the PPCR that will benefit private sector while contributing to address problems of climate change resilience.

Nevertheless, the proposal is good for CIF funding consideration. Best wishes.
