

Tiger 2000 – Full Depth In-Place Asphalt Reclamation

The Tiger 2000 is a pavement recycling machine (1,260 hp/145,000 lb) that recycles asphalt pavement and a predetermined amount of the underlying base to produce a well-graded base course material. The Tiger 2000 cuts and strips a 10' width up to 24" deep, through the pavement and into the base. It pulverizes and then blends the pavement and base materials into a homogeneous mix and transfers the processed material to an adjacent lane or truck. By performing these steps simultaneously, the machine eliminates the multiple steps of reclaiming, hauling, processing, and material re-handling that other processes require. Teigen's Tiger 2000 is a high production machine for primary and secondary road replacement.
