Comments from United Kingdom on Cambodia's Strategic Programme for Climate Resilience

The UK is pleased that all SPCRs were endorsed at the sub-committee meeting. We suggest the following areas for improvement/consideration:

Areas for improvement

- Indicators, baselines and risk management strategies should be further developed as components and projects are developed. (The current risk level is medium, and this will need further attention.)
- The strategy for capacity building within national institutions should be elaborated, and should consider issues surrounding coordination and synergy (for example, factoring in what the Cambodia Climate Change Alliance (CCCA) is doing).
- Governance and Programme management arrangements need to be further articulated, particularly: the role of the Ministry of Economy and Finance; the decision making and monitoring of the lead agencies in each component; and the involvement of donors and CCCA.
- The involvement of civil society and the private sector should also be elaborated.
