Background

- Implementation commenced in 2012; initial cost USD 20.92 m
- Additional finance in 2014, new total cost – USD61.52m
- Closing date : 2018
- Coordinated by the Central Planning Division, Ministry of Finance and Economic Planning
- Largely agency/organisation driven – work programmes, ToRs, specifications etc.

M&R : National Structure

- PPCR M&R integrated into existing national structure.
 - Coordinated by Monitoring Unit, CPD within Ministry of Finance and Economic Planning supported by M&R consultant.
- M&R team is part of the imp. team and steering comm.
 - Detailed knowledge of what is happening
 - Build relationship with partner agencies
 - Making the link between activities and success indicators
 - Spot problem issues and recommend changes
- 3 Levels: Allows stakeholder engagement at various levels
 - Cabinet - **Policy**
 - Steering Committee – **Agencies**
 - Activity – **On the ground**

SPCR M&R Process – 7 Steps

- 1. Sensitisation Workshop** – Re-familiarise stakeholders with the process/procedure/requirements (forms, changes); Review FY 2013 report; mock scoring exercise; review and discuss scoring criteria; finalise criteria;
- 2. Face to Face Interviews** (A discussion, not just complete a form!) aimed to:
 - Review and update priorities
 - Complete scorecards
 - **Questions are based on areas to be assessed in each indicators**
 - **Transcript of interviews kept for report**

2 Groups of Interviewees (for holistic view on CCA/DRR in SVG):

 - Representatives - key stakeholders in the sectors integral to the ***implementation of the SPCR***
 - Representatives of agencies which implement activities/programmes which ***contribute to*** the achievement SPCR objectives (indicator 1 and 2).
 - Public and Private Sectors and NGOs.

SPCR M&R Process – 7 Steps

3. Collate data based on interviews

4. Validation of Data

- Workshop format – all persons interviewed attend
- Each sector addressed in turn
- Discussion on scores – All stakeholders weigh in
- Obtain consensus (scorecard is update)

5. Analyse Data

- what has changed; why/why not; themes;trends;

6. Report – to CIF/WB; Stakeholders

7. Learn, adjust, adapt, transform

- what is good, great, could be better, how?

Reflections/Take-aways

- Learn from us/others but find what works for you/in your context.
- Sensitisation workshop is useful – prepares stakeholders for what is to come.
- Document interviews, have transcripts ready for reference in report prep.
- Have your scoring criteria finalized as early as possible and involve stakeholders in the finalization process
