Country Pilots: USD40-50 million per country

Regional pilot programs: USD60-75 million per program

Concessional Loans:

2009 Programming and Financing Modalities for the SCF Targeted Program, the Pilot Program for Climate Resilience (PPCR) provides:

“... in accessing concessional loans, an initial ceiling is agreed of 20% of the total available concessional finance amount per pilot program. This ceiling will be kept under review and will be reevaluated after the submission of the first three to five Strategic Programs.”

(currently USD358 million are to be used as concessional finance)
