1. Introduction

- 1. This semi-annual Disbursement Report was prepared by the CIF Administrative Unit in collaboration with the Multilateral Development Banks (MDBs), and covers cumulative disbursements as of <u>June 30, 2017</u>. The main report focuses on the disbursements for <u>the overall CIF portfolio</u>, while Annexes A-D show the disbursement figures per CIF program¹ (CTF, PPCR, FIP, and SREP) at country-level and project-level². Further analysis on disbursements as well as project pipeline tracking per program is presented in the Semi-Annual Operational Report (SAR) for each program.
- 2. For the purpose of this report, "disbursement" means "funds transferred from MDBs to project recipients." The actual disbursement data reflects the disbursement status³ of project preparation grants (PPG) and project funding. Funding for MDB Project Implementation and Supervision (MPIS) is not included as part of the disbursement data. For guarantee projects, they are considered "100% disbursed" once the guarantee product becomes effective and can be withdrawn by its recipients, regardless of actual fund transfer. Details of guarantee projects are shown in the Annexes for CTF and SREP.
- 3. Disbursements for the Strategic Climate Fund (SCF) programs⁴ have started to increase, but they still remain at a lower level than CTF, which has been disbursing for two or three years longer. The CIF Administrative Unit will closely monitor and report disbursement progress every six months in various reports, such as the Semi-Annual Operational Report and Risk Report.

2. Overview of disbursement progress (CIF overall)







Figure 3: Trends in SCF disbursement ratio

4. As of June 30 2017, CIF cumulative disbursements amounted to <u>USD 2.47 billion</u> (Table 1). Disbursement trends have been steady over the last three years as noted in Figure 1. Disbursed amounts increased by USD 500 million per year while the disbursement ratio (percentage disbursed from MDB approved amount) reached 42 percent at the end of fiscal year (FY) 2017⁵. The cumulative disbursement in FY17 in the SCF grew by USD 210 million with a 10-percentage-point increase in disbursement ratio⁶ - see Figure 3.

5. 164 of 207 MDB approved projects, are either disbursing or have fully disbursed its project funding. This does not include projects only with PPG disbursement. Disbursing projects account for 79 percent of MDB approved projects. The difference between approved and disbursing projects can be explained by the newly approved projects. It takes approximately one year between MDB approval and the first disbursement, while may be some variability among projects.
