IDB RESPONSE TO COMMENTS FROM UNITED STATES

A1: This has already been confirmed by the public utility (ENEE), and the bank has reviewed the property ownership documents. The landowner is willing to sell the land for the project and once the project will be approved by IDB, ENEE will start the formal process to buy it.

A2: The public consultations will take place once IDB receives news from the approval of the project proposal. Since the communities where the project will be implemented do not have electricity, the public utility prefers to avoid raising further their expectations, and has decided not to make the public consultation until the proposal is approved by the SREP Subcommittee. During the preparation of feasibility studies, the community and local authorities have been supportive with the project.
