

Deforestation rate



GHG Emissions-Brazil - 1990-2010 (CO₂eq)





An undeniable success story

GHG emissions reductions reached in 2010 in relation to previous Inventories (in 1000 ton of CO2eq)



By 2011, Brazil reduced more emissions than the US and the EU pledged to reduce by 2020.





What was done?

Action Plan to Combat Deforestation (14 ministries involved) Different policies and incentives were put in place:

- expansion of protected areas and indigenous reserves
- command and control actions
- strong monitoring systems
- financial regulations and policies addressing the drivers of deforestation (especially agriculture)
- engagement of civil society and private sector.
- external support financial incentive and capacity building
