RESULTS FROM THE CONSULTATIONS ON THE SELECTION OF SEATS FOR THE SCF SUB-COMMITTEES

Proposed Decision of the Joint Meeting of the CTF and SCF Trust Fund Committees

The Joint Meeting of the CTF/ SCF Trust Fund Committees takes note of the results from the Consultations on the selection of seats for the SCF Sub-committees.

Results from the Consultations on the Selection of Seats for the SCF Sub-Committees

1. Consultations were held on June 23, 2011, for the purpose of agreeing upon seats for the three SCF Sub-Committees (for FIP, PPCR and SREP).
2. A preliminary list of countries selected to identify representatives to serve as members on the SCF Sub-Committees is attached as an annex.
3. It should be noted that the contributor country group agreed to continue the practice of having “twinning” arrangements under which two countries would share one seat. The two partnering countries will agree how to rotate representatives to serve as the member for the seat. The contributor country group also noted that it would need some additional time to confirm its selection, since not all contributors were present at the consultations.
4. The CIF Administrative Unit will request each government of a country chosen to serve on a Sub-Committee to provide the name and contact information of the person who will serve as the Sub-Committee member.
