






 and Zambia
- PPCR (8): Bhutan; Gambia; Honduras; Kyrgyz Republic; Madagascar; Malawi;
 Philippines; and Rwanda
- SREP (1): Lesotho
- SREP Investment plans for Benin, Madagascar, Kiribati, Malawi, Sierra Leone, Yemen, and Zambia are under preparation
- An extension was provided to Honduras until June, 2018 to submit their FIP Investment Plan









Update on Key CIF Activities – @CIF in Action

- South Africa's Kaxu Solar One Project wins Momentum for Change Award
 - A 100MW plant
 - First concentrated solar power plant in the country
 - Generate electricity as well as store energy
- Cambodia and Zambia South-South Exchange
 - 17 Zambians went to Phnom Penh,
 Siem Reap, Battambang and Pursat in Cambodia
- Results from the PPCR knowledge and learning exchange shared in Virtual Reality sessions this week.









Update on Key CIF Activities – @CIF in Action

- FIP Pilot Country Meetings took place in Lao PDR
 - Nearly 200 delegates from 50 countries
 - Knowledge product on Gender and Forests
- PPCR LAC Knowledge Exchange
 - Learning platform to track and evaluate effectiveness of these
- SREP Roundtable and mini-grids event held in Nigeria
 - Organized in association with ESMAP
 - 9 SREP African countries participated
- Partnership with Global Delivery Initiative (GDI),
 - To inform development practice and improve implementation

The analysis of CTF 2.0 has continued, with significant progress



- Suggests opportunities to improve reporting practices

Update on Evaluation and Learning (E&L) Initiative

- ✓ Learning starting to emerge from key Cross-cutting Evaluations:
 - Transformational Change: Learning Partnership workshops; dimensions; initial portfolio analysis
 - Evaluation of CIF Programmatic Approach: Initial findings shared, full report in February
 - E&L activities on Financing Forest Enterprises, DGM for Indigenous Peoples, PPCR Learning Partner and others on track and will yield results in early 2018
- ✓ Strategically-aligned **Call for Proposals** activities
- ✓ Focus next year on generating insights on transformational change, through evaluations and capstone synthesis report, to inform CIF@10, strategic discussions, and wider dissemination.
