


Investment Plans

2 IPs expected to be endorsed in FY19





Analysis of long terms costs for the SCF

- Detailed analysis of SCF costs presented in March, 2018
- SCF Trust Fund Committee requested additional cost scenarios
- Additional analysis will follow after discussions on sunset.





CIF Gender Policy approved

- Underlines CIF's commitment to enhancement of gender equality outcomes across its programming
- Commitment to support a genderresponsive approach and women's agency in a transformational change context
- Maintains primacy of MDB policies on gender and social safeguards at project level
- Commitment to accountability and learning under the CIF gender policy
- Collaboration with other climate finance institutions on gender and climate
- Introduces **Gender Representatives** into CIF governance structure of observers





Improving reporting in SREP

The SREP stocktaking exercise was devised to review the effectiveness, relevance and utility of the SREP M&R system

Assessing SREP M&R

System design and guidance: suitability of indicators and data collection Reporting, data collection, pilot country engagement and quality assurance





Collaboration with the GCF

- Formal and informal collaboration between secretariats (gender, M&R, risk management, evaluation and learning, and readiness support)
- Joint process to assess the likelihood of GCF funding for unfunded SCF pipeline
- MDBs are likely to seek GCF funding for 1
 SREP and 3 PPCR projects


