PPCR SEMI-ANNUAL OPERATIONAL REPORT

Proposed Decision by PPCR Sub-Committee

The Sub-Committee reviewed document PPCR/SC.10/3, *PPCR Semi-Annual Operational Report*, and welcomes the progress that has been made in advancing the work of the PPCR in the pilot countries and regions. The Sub-Committee notes with appreciation that SPCRs for most of the PPCR pilots have now been submitted for endorsement and are entering into implementation.

I. INTRODUCTION

- 1. The purpose of this note is to provide the PPCR Sub-Committee with a semi-annual report on the status of PPCR activities. This report covers the period from November 1, 2011 to April 15, 2012.
- 2. As PPCR is in its operational phase, the semi-annual report provides data and information on meeting key benchmarks which are indicators of progress in the PPCR pilot countries, including dates on :
 - a) endorsement of SPCRs;
 - b) projects and programs approved by the Sub-Committee;
 - c) projects and programs approved by the MDBs;
 - d) effectiveness of a project or program (signature of grant or loan agreement between the pilot country government and the MDB); and
 - e) first disbursement.
- 3. This data is provided through the SCF pipeline management system¹, which captures all relevant data for the SCF targeted programs, including the FIP. An important objective of pipeline management is to contribute to the effectiveness and efficiency of the SCF and its targeted programs by providing predictability and confidence in the management of the funds to the Sub-Committees as well as to the country teams that are responsible for preparing programs and projects under endorsed SPCRs.

II. STATUS OF PPCR COUNTRY AND REGIONAL PILOTS

Endorsements of Strategic Programs for Climate Resilience

- 4. During its November 2011 meeting, the Sub-Committee reviewed and endorsed the SPCRs for Bolivia and Jamaica and agreed to the further development of activities foreseen in them. A total of USD 65 million in grant resources and USD 46 million in PPCR credits were requested for the development and implementation of identified priority actions.
- 5. SPCRs for Dominica, Tonga, Yemen and the regional tracks for the Caribbean and Pacific programs have been submitted for review and endorsement by the PPCR Sub-Committee at its upcoming meeting. As of March 31, 2012 thirteen pilot countries have completed their programming process and will now be preparing projects and programs agreed in the endrosed SPCRs: Bangladesh; Bolivia; Cambodia; Grenada, Jamaica, Mozambique; Nepal; Niger; Samoa, St. Lucia, St. Vincent and the Grenadines, Tajikistan; and Zambia.

6. The remaining PPCR pilot countries, Haiti, participating in the Carribbean regional program and Papua New Guinea, participating in the Pacific regional program are in the process of finalizing their SPCRs for submission in 2012.

Update on Haiti

- 7. Haiti continuous to be committed to the PPCR process and actively participated at the recent meeting of PPCR pilot countries in Zambia in April 2012. The country programming process is ongoing in accordance with the Phase 1 proposal that was submitted by Haiti and approved by the PPCR Sub-Committee in April 2011.
- 8. A joint mission led by Government of Haiti and supported by the relevant MDBs, is tentatively planned for the end of May 2012 with the objective to further advance to the dialogue with key stakeholders and the SPCR preparation. The SPCR is expected to be submitted for endorsement no later than by the next meeting of the PPCR Sub-Committee in November 2012.

Update on Papua New Guinea

- 9. The PNG SPCR is in the final stages of development and will be submitted by mail in June 2012.
- 10. A second joint programming mission led by the government and ADB was conducted in April 2012 with participation of the World Bank , UNDP, AusAID, and Pacific regional organizations (PIFs, SPREP). This mission also secured the governments' endorsement of the draft SPCR.
- 11. The PNG SPCR will contribute to "transformational" changes by supporting the implementation of PNGs' national strategy, outlined in its Vision 2050, NDP, MTDP, PIP and Climate Compatible Development Plan (CCDP) to make PNGs' development investments resilient to the impacts of climate vulnerability and change. The SPCR will enhance PNGs' capacity to effectively respond to the impacts of climate vulnerability and change through strengthened human and institutional resources, enhanced knowledge and tools, and more climate resilient infrastructure. These are prerequisites for effective social development, food security and overall poverty alleviation.

Project Approvals

- 12. During the reporting period, the PPCR Sub-Committee reviewed and approved PPCR funding for the following projects:
 - a) Cambodia Climate Proofing of Roads in Prey Veng, Svay Rieng, Kampong Chang and Kampong Speu Provinces (ADB), with a PPCR allocation of US\$17 million (US\$7 million in grants and \$US 10 million in credits);
 - b) Nepal Mainstreaming Climate Change Risk Management in Development (ADB), with a PPCR grant allocation of US\$7.2 million; and

- c) Niger Community Action Project for Climate Resilience (CAPCR)(IBRD) with a PPCR allocation of US\$63.6 million (US\$35.6 million in grants and \$US 28 million in credits);
- 13. As of March 31, 2012, PPCR funding for eight projects have been approved by the Sub-Committee totaling USD 127.5million in PPCR resources (USD77.7 million in grant resources and USD 49.2 million in near-zero interest credits). These resources are expected to leverage a total of USD 105.2 million in co-financing.

III. PPCR PIPELINE

Project Approval Calendar

- 14. The Trust Fund Committee is being presented with a status of PPCR project approvals for the Fiscal Year (FY) 2013. The calendar reflects updates from MDBs on their pipelines showing expected dates for project submissions and project amounts for the upcoming financial year. It is a useful tool for proactively tracking funding demands so to better match available resources with demands and shall form an integral part of future reports. The project approval calendar, "PPCR FY13 Approval of Projects", is attached as annex 2.
- 15. The expected total amount of PPCR funding requested for financing 33 projects and programs under endorsed investment plans in FY13 amounts to US\$442.3 million. The expected available funding for FY 2013 would be sufficient to cover these requests.

Traffic-Light System

Introduction

- 16. In June 2011, a proposal was made for a tracking light system to flag the delivery status of investment plans, projects and programs². This system will be introduced as a tool to manage the PPCR pipeline and to track progress of the PPCR project activities.
- 17. The traffic light system for PPCR replicates a tool that has been tried and tested in the Clean Technology Fund. It is the collaborative output of the CIF Administrative Unit and the MDB committee and should track two key milestones of project delivery³. The first set of traffic lights track for each project or program the time from the date of submission originally indicated when the PPCR pipeline was constituted to the currently expected date of submission to the Sub-Committee for funding approval⁴. The second set of traffic lights track the time from the Sub-Committee approval of PPCR funding for a project or program to the expected MDB approval of the project⁵.
- 18. To track Sub-Committee approval, the following traffic lights are applied:

19. To track MDB approval, the following traffic lights are applied for public sector projects:

Green: Within 9 months from the date of Sub-Committee approval to the

(expected) date of MBD approval

Yellow: 9 to 12 months from the date of Sub-Committee approval to the (expected)

date of MBD approval

Red: Above 12 months from the date of Sub-Committee approval to the

(expected) date of MBD approval

20. For private sector programs, the respective traffic lights for tracking MDB approval are as follows:

Green: Within 9 months from the date of Sub-Committee approval to the present

date for at least one-third of the funds within the program for financial sector programs and within 18 months for infrastructure projects

Yellow: 9 to 18 months from the date of Sub-Committee approval to the present

date for at least one-third of the funds within the program for financial

sector programs and under 27 months for infrastructure projects

Red: Above 18 months from the date of Sub-Committee approval to the present

date for at least one-third of the funds within the program for financial

sector programs and above 27 months for infrastructure projects

21. The current PPCR pipeline contains 53 projects which are being developed or have reached implementation status under endorsed SPCRs.

22. For the 8 projects that have reached the stage of MDB approval, all of them met the established benchmark for Sub-Committee approval and 7 are on track to meet the benchmark for MDB approvals. One project received Sub-Committee approval, but has now exceeded the agreed benchmark for being on track for MDB approval.

and the MDBs and 20 projects have fallen behind target for Sub-Committee approval.

23. For the remaining 45 projects under endorsed SPCRs awaiting Sub-Committee approval, 25 are on the track to meet the anticipated date for both, approval by the PPCR Sub-Committee
