## Overview

- Joint meeting of CTF/SCR Trust Fund Committees on 3 Nov. 2011 approved measures to improve the operations of the CIF. One key measure requested **simplified results frameworks**.
- Zambia Pilot Country Meeting 2012: in depth discussions
- Revised version: 31 Aug 2012; consultation in Sept 12
- Revised version: 19 Oct 2012
- Cambodia and Mozambique M&E “showcases”
- PPCR Pilot Country Meeting on 30 Oct 2012 concluded that the results framework **had not become sufficiently simplified**; many indicators could prove to be very difficult to be tracked in country.
- PPCR pilot country volunteers supported by MDBs worked on modifications (evening session on 30 Oct 2012)

## Issues

- All **key elements retained**, no additions to the RFW itself
- **Focus:**
  - 4 core indicators
  - 7 optional indicators
- Integration of the SPCR results framework into **national monitoring and evaluation systems** is a basic principle
- Clarity on next steps, e.g. **establishing baselines and targets** and **reporting** cycles (Proposed Decision p2)
- Implement results framework and **review** quality, validity, usefulness and measurability of **core indicators in 2016**

# Core indicators

- A1.3 - Numbers of people supported by the PPCR to cope with effects of climate change**
- A2.1 - Degree of integration of climate change in national, including sector planning**
- B1 - Extent to which vulnerable households, communities businesses and public sector services use improved PPCR supported tools, instruments, strategies, activities to respond to CV&CC**
- B2 - Evidence of strengthened government capacity and coordination mechanism to mainstream climate resilience**

## Pilot Program for Climate Resilience (PPCR) – REVISED logic model

**Global** - CIF Final Outcome  
(15-20 yrs)

Improved climate resilient development consistent with other CIF objectives

**Country** - Contribution of SPCR to Transformative Impact  
(10-20 yrs / national level)

Increased resilience of households, communities, businesses, sectors and society to CV & CC

Strengthened climate responsive development planning

In order to prepare for and respond to CV & CC ...

Adaptive capacities strengthened

Institutional framework improved

Climate information in decision making routinely applied

Sector planning, and regulation for climate resilience improved
