EXPRESSIONS OF INTEREST TO PARTICIPATE IN THE SREP

1. At its meeting in October 2013, the SREP Sub-Committee agreed in principle to open the SREP to new countries and requested the CIF Administrative Unit to invite countries eligible for SREP funding to submit an expression of interest in participating in the SREP. The Sub-Committee further agreed that an expert group should be established to review the expressions of interest and to identify up to 12 new countries that could benefit from the SREP program while contributing to the overall programmatic objectives of SREP.

2. In March 2014, the Sub-Committee approved the *Criteria and Process for Selecting New Pilot Countries under the SREP*, including a list of countries eligible for SREP funding. The CIF Administrative Unit, in collaboration with the MDBs, invited 55 eligible countries to submit an expression of interest to participate in the SREP. In response to the invitation, 40 countries submitted detailed expressions of interest.
