SREP Impact indicators



Support low carbon development pathways by reducing energy poverty and increasing energy security

❖ Indicator 1: National measure of 'energy poverty' such as Energy Development Index (EDI) or the Multi-dimensional Energy Poverty Index

- ❖ Indictor 2: Annual electricity output from RE in GWh
- Indicator 3: Increased public and private investments (\$) in targeted subsector(s) per country per year

SREP Program Outcomes indicators



Result 1: Increased supply of renewable energy

Indicator: Annual electricity output from RE as a result of SREP interventions(GWh)

Result 2: Increased access to modern energy services

Indicator: Number of women and men, community services and businesses benefitting from improved access to electricity and fuels as a result of SREP interventions

Linking projects/programs with investment plan objectives



The pilot country is the **central reporting unit!**

This requires that we work together to establish **good baseline data and targets** for the five core indicators

This approach requires that projects/programs submitted for Sub-Committee approval ...

- ... clearly articulate how the outputs will contribute to an SREP outcome
- ... demonstrate how project/program design is aimed to maximize cobenefits
- ... include a DRAFT project/program results framework with a concise set of output and outcome indicators for review

Reporting will evolve over time. The semi-annual operations report will focus on portfolio development and the Annual Report will focus increasingly on tangible results.
