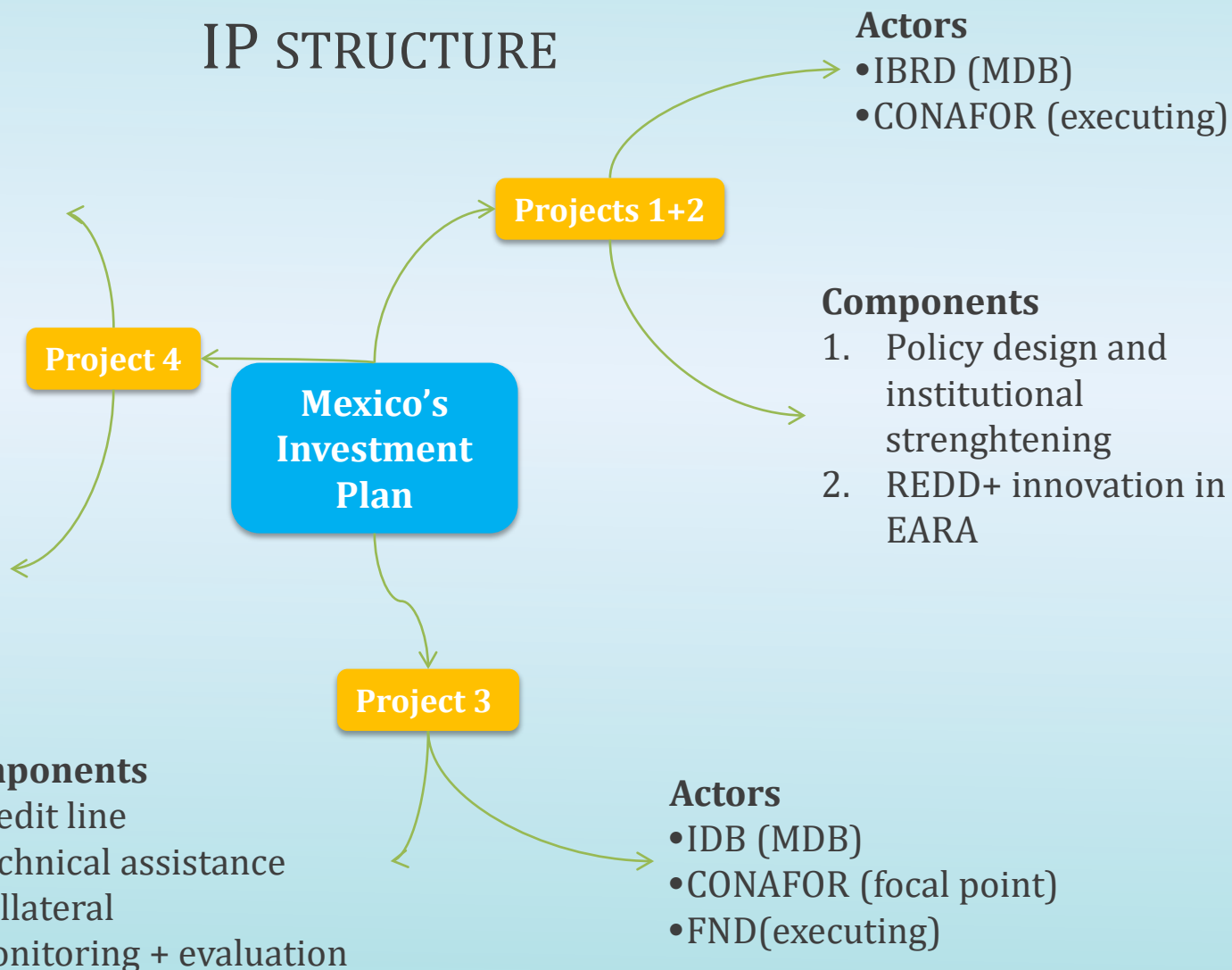

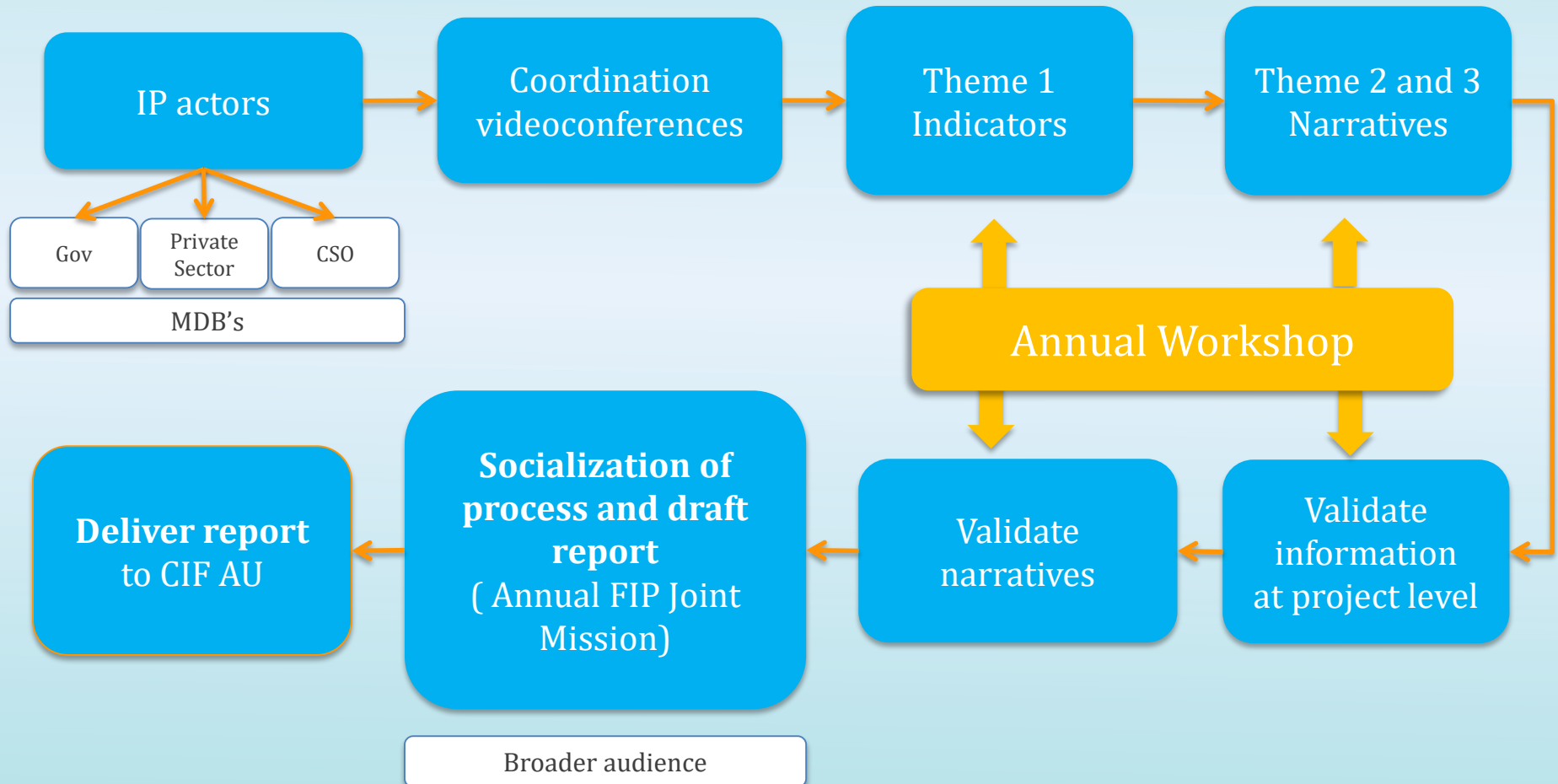

Mexico's process

1. Data collection and results compilation

- Videoconferences with FIP actors to present:
 - ✓ New reporting template
 - ✓ Integration strategy and reporting timeline
 - ✓ Clarify reporting of theme 1 indicators.
- FIP focal point gathered information:
 - ✓ Indicators (from project results framework)
 - ✓ Preliminary conceptual narratives

Mexico's process

2. Annual Workshop

- Presentations by executing agency (2016 achievements and indicators) to homologate knowledge
- Work groups according to area of expertise to develop narratives
- Facilitated plenary discussions to validate narratives.

Mexico's process

3. *Quality Assurance*

- CONAFOR, as FIP focal point in Mexico, calls for a Joint Mission, an annual meeting to review the implementation of the FIP investment plan.
- Socialization of M+R process within a wider stakeholder group.
- Organized dynamic activities helped attendants provide complementary information or perspective.

4. *Report writing*

- A consultant was hired by IBRD to facilitate both events, document them and work along FIP focal point to write the report.
- Draft report was then shared with all FIP actors for final validation
- Submittance to CIF M+R team, and further clarification.

Mexico's experience with the new FIP M&R system

Lessons Learned

- FIP reporting system is useful in providing particular project implementers with an articulated, broader view of IP impact (Programmatic approach).
- The new narrative report system and its validation process, while challenging, helps stakeholders to jointly tell an impact story, beyond figures or criteria.
- Sharing successes and challenges with other stakeholders generates strategic alliances to complement initiatives.



Mexico's experience with the new FIP M&R system

Lessons Learned

- Some information collected reflected changes at policy level, some on the ground and must be reflected accordingly.
- It is key to establish and share in advance, the evidences for the report, with key stakeholders.
- Identify consultants strengths: facilitation, analysis, report writing.
- Report IP results, must be based upon the existing national measuring tools and current M&E system.
